The video link would not connect so Rex Plant was interviewed by phone as a candidate for the Police Chief position.


ACT, IF NECESSARY, REGARDING MATTERS DISCUSSED IN VIDEO CONFERENCE

Alderman Ivey moved to offer the position of Police Chief to Rex Plant at an annual salary of \$63,000, hours worked past 40 per week will be paid at a straight time wage of \$30.29 per hour, a department audit conducted prior to Plant becoming responsible for the police department evidence and inventory, with one weekend per month, Friday, Saturday and Sunday to travel and spend time with his family, seconded by Alderman Bailey. The vote was unanimous in favor.
